- 1. Click in the address bar, where it says learnmyway.com.
- 2. Delete everything in the address bar and type **www.gov.uk/find-a-job** then press **Enter**.
- 3. Select the **Start** button.
- 4. Select the **What?** box and type an example job.
- 5. Select the **Where?** box and type an location.
- 6. Select the **Search** button and look at some of the results.
- 7. Take a note of how many jobs are listed.
- 8. Scroll to the top of the screen and select the **Advanced search** option (below the Search button).
- 9. Refine your search by entering some options into the Advanced Job Search page.
- 10. Scroll down the screen and select the **Search** button and look at some of the results.
