Commitment to achieving Net Zero

Good Things Foundation is committed to achieving Net Zero emissions by 2050.

Baseline Emissions Footprint

Baseline emissions are a record of the greenhouse gases that have been produced in the past and were produced prior to the introduction of any strategies to reduce emissions. Baseline emissions are the reference point against which emissions reduction can be measured.

Baseline Year: 2023

Additional Details relating to the Baseline Emissions calculations:

Good Things Foundation operates a blended model of remote home working and a co-working office. There are no company vehicles or on site manufacturing processes.

Scope 1 The owner and operator of the co-working office was Spaces (IWG PLC) who in 2023 were carbon neutral and therefore we have assumed nil emissions from office space.

Scope 2 Good Things Foundation did not purchase energy during the baseline year and so have recorded nil emissions

Scope 3 In the baseline year we recorded vehicle emissions based on annual mileage claims for business travel.

Emissions reduction targets

This is Good Things Foundation's first Carbon Footprint and Reduction Plan.

Since recording the baseline Good Things Foundation has moved to a new co-working office (June 2024). We also accept that there is more in our upstream and downstream (Scope 3) activities that we could understand and influence.

We anticipate that reviewing the impact of our recent office move and extending the baseline of our Scope 3 emissions beyond business mileage during 2024 will increase our reported carbon footprint beyond the current baseline, therefore we plan to set a target % and tCO2e reduction once we have established a more comprehensive baseline by the end of this year.

We will set targets and track progress against targets in future years and report projected versus actual.

We have identified a number of carbon reduction initiatives that will help us to contribute more fully to the UK government Net Zero ambitions.

Carbon Reduction Initiatives

Good Things Foundation has an Ethical/Sustainable Purchasing Policy and a Travel Policy that takes sustainable travel into account with definitions of necessary travel.

In 2024 we will:

- Assess the emissions of our new co-working space, reporting the impact of the office move we made in June 2024
- Understand the baseline for our wider service offering including our upstream and downstream activities, and set targets, by end 2024
- Create an appropriate reduction plan for our upstream and downstream activities by end 2024

These activities will be reviewed and signed off by the Senior Management Team and reported to the Board of Trustees.

Declaration and Sign Off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.

Emissions have been reported and recorded in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the <u>GHG Reporting Protocol corporate standard</u> and uses the appropriate <u>Government emission conversion factors for greenhouse gas company reporting</u>.

Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions have been reported in accordance with SECR requirements, and the required subset of Scope 3 emissions have been reported in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the <u>Corporate Value Chain</u> (Scope 3) Standard.
