Games

Hexablock - number block merge
Flow Free - connect matching colours with a line
Ball Sort - sort coloured balls in tubes
Number Match - match pairs of numbers and clear the board
Puzzle Party - online jigsaw puzzles

Guess the Line - The game where Al judges your drawing skills

3D Pottery - sculpt your own historical pot
